Lab Demonstrations

Each laboratory done in EECS 388 requires a demonstration of the lab exercise to your TA. Lab demos must be completed before the lab report for a given lab is to be turned in (a late demo counts as late work, and is not accepted). If you do not demo a lab before the last laboratory is over, you must make an appointment to demo your lab with your TA and/or meet with your TA during their office hours.

Additionally, making an appointment to demo your lab is not an extra laboratory session in which your TA will help you debug your project. If extra help is needed you must make a concerted effort outside of class to work on your own and/or you may ask questions during office hours or by appointment.

So to finalize, if you make an appointment to demo your lab then it should be ready to demo as soon as the appointment begins. If you have already demonstrated your project to your TA during the last day of the lab, then you are all set. The grade for each lab will be based upon the quality and completeness of your demo and your lab report.
